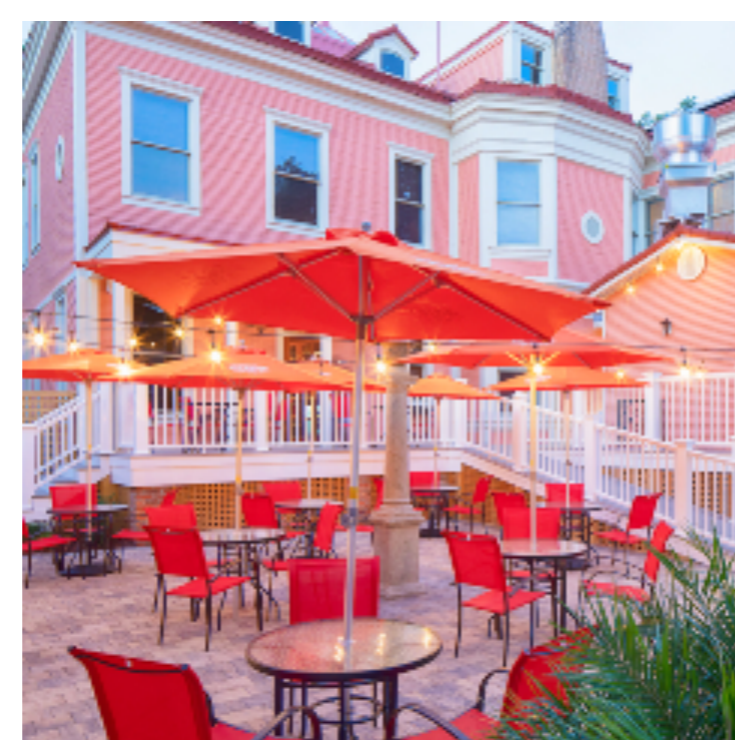
Scholarship Applications Open for 2019 Savannah Sports Council Scholar Athletes

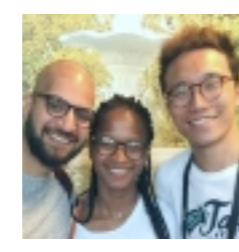
Sports Council to Hire Sports Event Manager

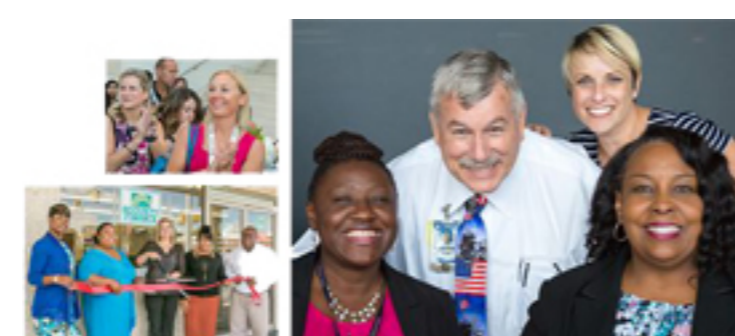
