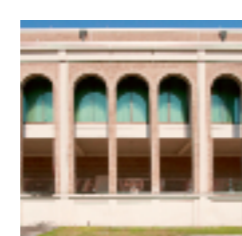

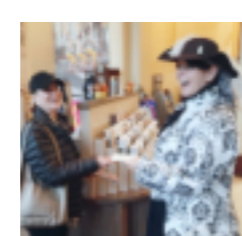
Consul General of Ireland Touts New Georgia Southern Wexford Campus

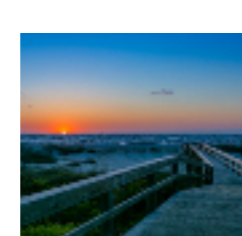

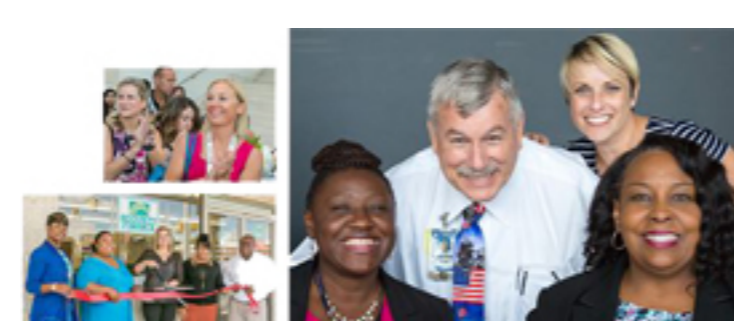
