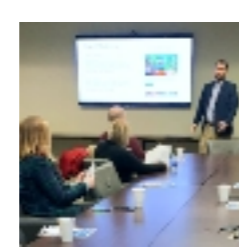

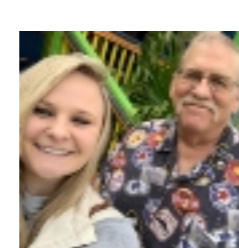
Visit Savannah Connects with International Operators

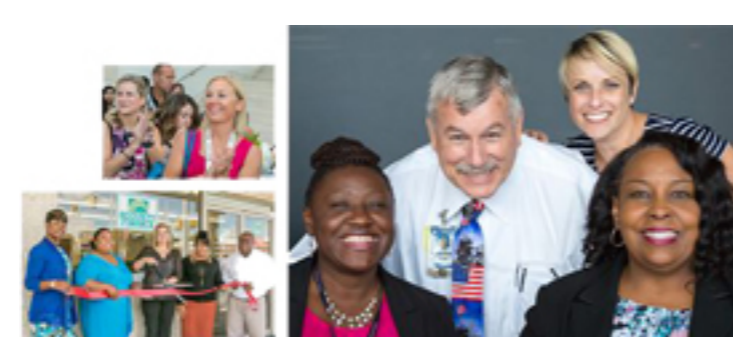
