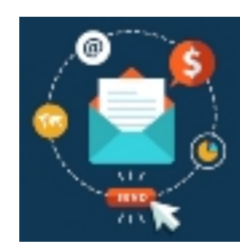
Visit Savannah & Partners Honored with First-Ever "Travelblazer" Award by GACVB

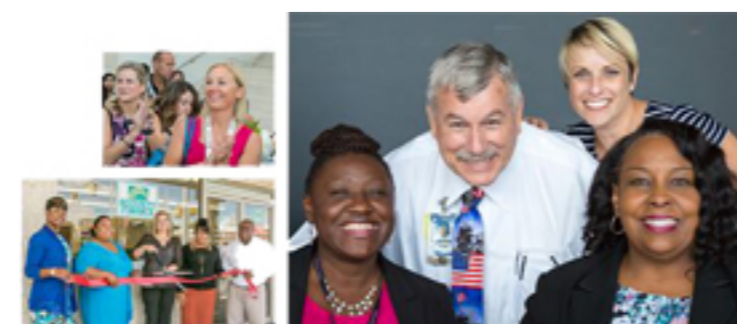
