QUEST is a program offered through the Office of College & Career Readiness (OCCR). Students who apply will have the opportunity to explore careers and participate in career related activities. OCCR, in partnership with local business and industry, is dedicated to exposing students to the broad range of available career and occupational opportunities. The program helps students gain workplace knowledge and competencies, through field trips, guest speakers, industry tours and more.

Program Benefits:

- Allows Middle and High School students to begin career exploration through industry tours, volunteering, job shadowing, and internships
- Prepares students to make knowledgeable career and academic decisions for their future
- Helps students identify their knowledge, skills, abilities and other characteristics as they relate to exploring career options
- Helps students gain insight into the ethics and ideals of business
- Develops a better understanding of local and regional workplaces
- Identifies areas of career interest

- Industry and business tours for career exploration through hands-on experiences,
- Guest speakers invited to present new ideas and opportunities to students
- A total of 3-4 tours, workplace visits, and guest speakers for middle school students
- Monthly activities and participation in career preparation activities for high school students
- Potential for internships to provide work experience for 11th and 12th grade students
